MAKE A DIFFERENCE DAY (OCTOBER 28) - PROFESSIONAL APPAREL DRIVE

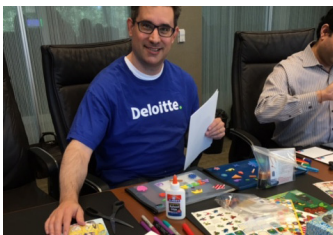
UWGMC partners with local agencies that support men & women returning to or starting out in the workplace by providing training and appropriate workplace attire.
