When **Ivonne** lost her job as a manager at a local fast-food restaurant, everything changed overnight. Suddenly, the bills she had always managed to keep up with felt impossible. Her savings disappeared quickly. With no income, no food, and rent coming due, Ivonne faced the very real fear of losing her home.

She called United Way of Greater Mercer County as a last resort, unsure if anyone could help, but hoping someone would listen.

She found support in **Saniyyah**, a **UWGMC Resource Specialist** who walked with her through every step of her crisis.

Together, they worked to restore Ivonne's stability and dignity:

- Ensured Ivonne applied for and received unemployment benefits
- Helped her apply for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits so she could have reliable access to food
- Assisted her with applying for health insurance
- Referred her to partner agencies for rental assistance
- Connected her to the Mercer County One-Stop Center for employment and training opportunities
- Guided her to local food pantries and provided a \$50 grocery gift card for immediate relief

While many agencies were forced to pause services due to the federal funding freeze, **United Way of Greater Mercer County did not stop**. We continued showing up for our neighbors because crises don't wait for government budgets to reopen.

And the truth is simple: we could only do this because of donors like you.
